2022 Self-Review Report 3 November 2022

A self-review of Horowhenua Learning Centre's [HLC] performance against the Code has been undertaken and a gap analysis completed. An attestation was submitted to NZQA on the 1 November 2022.

HLC currently has 63 domestic students enrolled on NZQA approved programmes. Thirty nine students are under the age of 18 years old at the time of this report

In relation to outcomes 1 to 4: (1) A learner wellbeing and safety systems, (2) Learner voice,
(3) Safe, inclusive, supportive and accessible physical and digital learning environments and
(4) Learners are safe and well – HLC has implemented processes in place.

The following outcomes do not apply to HLC:

- Outcomes 5 to 7: HLC does not provide student accommodation.
- Outcomes 8 to 12: HLC does not enrol international students.
